2. Description of the visit programme

The University of Udine (Italy) offers three (3) PhD students (student mobility) and two (2) researchers (staff mobility) from partner African universities in the UnitAfrica project the opportunity to spend three months in its research laboratories, collaborating with its professors and engaging in joint research activities.

The purpose of these visits in to enhance the research capacity of scientists, helping them to foster linkages for further collaboration.

3. Requirements and Eligibility

Applicants must be a PhD student or a researcher from one of the African partner universities of the UnitAfrica Project (Annex 2)

Applicants' scientific field of research must be one those listed under section 2. Only applications within these fields will be considered.

Before submitting an application, candidates must contact a University of Udine professor (internal supervisor) working in one of the identified target research areas (section 2), share their proposal with him/her and obtain his/her approval/signature (see Annex 1). The contact person listed in the table in section 2 can assist potential applicants in identifying the most suitable supervisor within each Department.

4. Application documents and application deadline

The application must:

Be completed in English, signed by internal supervisor (section 3) and signed by the applicant;

- Include a copy of applicant's passport (only the page with personal details);
- Include a copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae;
- Include the full list of the applicant's scientific publications (do not enclose copies of the articles);
- Be sent to <u>sara.distefano@uniud.it</u> and <u>amce@uniud.it</u> within the application deadline.

Applications that do not meet these requirements will not be considered. The application deadline is June 6th, 2025.

5. Selection procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee composed of professors from the University of Udine, specializing in the scientific area relevant to the applicant's research.

Applicants will be selected on scientific merit, with the following criteria considered:

- relevance of the research area to the topics outlined in the call,
- validity and quality of the proposed research project,
- the applicant's curriculum vitae, with particular emphasis on experience and previous or ongoing research activities in the scientific research area linked to the submitted proposal,
- the number of publications related to the scientific research area of interest.

6. Rankings

9. Miscellaneous

Each beneficiary will remain registered full-time at their home institution and will continue to pay tuition and other fees there. The beneficiary will be responsible for the following:

- finding accommodation in Udine. However, the University of Udine will assist beneficiaries in locating housing, if possible,
- covering all expenses incurred in connection with participation in the program,
- arranging their own VISA and residence permit (if required)
- securing their own medical insurance to cover any potential medical expenses.

10. Administrative Procedures Responsible

In accordance with Article 4 of Law 241 of August 7, 1990, "New regulations on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents", the administrative procedures responsible are overseen by Ms. Cristina Disint, Head of the Student Services Area at the University of Udine.
