IsDB will financially support ideas that help curb the spread of COVID-19, minimise the socio-economic impact of the pandemic and build the resilience of the Bank's member countries in responding to outbreaks and pandemics long-term.

Thematics:

- Application of advanced technology
- Innovative health supply chain management system

PFIZER COMPETITIVE GRANT

Category A: independent medical education grants

Through this call, it is the intent to support educational programs for healthcare providers focused on the recognition, diagnosis, treatment, and overall care management of patients with COVID-19.

Category B: quality & process improvement grants

The intent of this grant category is to provide support to hospitals or healthcare systems so that they may evaluate and improve their systems-of-care for COVID-19 patients. Funds can be used for staff training or clinical process improvement.

NATIONAL CANCER INSTITUTE ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING AVAILABILITY OF URGENT COMPETITIVE REVISION AND ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPLEMENTS ON COVID-19

Topics of specific interest to NCI include understanding the basic mechanisms of interaction between SARS-CoV-2 and cancer cells, co-morbidities of cancer and SARS-CoV-2 infection (especially in disparately affected patient populations), and the impacts on treatment and clinical outcomes of SARS-CoV-2 infected persons in the context of cancer.
